### **Content Solution's Intern, Brittany Bailey Gets Accepted into Competitive Photography Program**

**Denton, Texas—May 2007:** Contents Solutions intern, Brittany Bailey, was accepted into the University of North Texas' (UNT) Visual Arts Photography Program. UNT is one of Texas' best Visual Arts Schools.

This four-year program requires over sixty hours of visual arts classes and is one of the most competitive programs at UNT. After completing many basic drawing, design, and beginners' photo classes, students must create a theme-based portfolio. This portfolio is reviewed and graded by photography professors. Portfolios are graded upon technical and creative aspects of black and white photography, each entrant is compared to the next. The top twenty portfolios out of approximately thirty-five make the cut, completing this entry review process and allowing the students to continue on to their first color class.

After completing the color course, another extensive portfolio, the mid-review, is required and is judged the same as the first. Only eighteen out of about thirty students are accepted beyond this point. The mid-review portfolio must consist of black and white along with color works to show the technical and creative abilities dealing with both medias. Due to the competitive edge of this program, the effort needed to succeed forces every student to work above and beyond what is expected.

"Getting pass the portfolio reviews and cuts have given me the courage to continue to do what I love best, capturing the essence of a moment," said Ms. Bailey. "I believe that this will contribute to future school and work projects."
